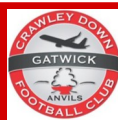
CHILDREN'S COOK BOOK

CRAWLEY DOWN SUPPORT NETWORK

As a volunteer for the Support Network since the beginning of lockdown in March, I just wanted to say a few words about what a wonderful experience it has been. I think I speak for all of my fellow volunteers that have been involved that it has given us all a great sense of purpose during these troubled and difficult times. Being able to use our time productively to help those in need has been truly amazing. The feedback we have received from all of those who we have helped has been marvellous.

I also think it was set up and ran so well. Talking to friends and relatives in other parts of the country, there have not been such set ups that have given such security and peace of mind to everyone - both the volunteers, with the "buddying" scheme and the "customers" with the safe and secure way their payments were dealt with.

I think it was said that we have undertaken well over 400 shopping and pharmacy run tasks amounting to over £2,300 worth being dealt with securely and safely with over the phone card payments and bank transfers.

On behalf of all the volunteers I would like to say a massive thank you to all involved, especially to all of the volunteers themselves and to Andrew, Hannah, Craig and Emma.

She then went on to introduce our guest speaker for the evening, Sally Botwright, whose talk was entitled "The Old London Docks and New Docklands".

Sally is a Blue Badge Guide for London and she had previously spoken to us in August 2019. Sally began her presentation by describing the development of the docks from their earliest days in Roman times. At that point in time, the docks had only been a sheltered import and export hub. However, in order to cope with the growth of worldwide trade in goods varying from tobacco, spices, cotton and even livestock, additional docks were constructed, by hand would you believe, as this was prior to the days of mechanisation. She showed us numerous photographs and illustrations of the docks and the shipping over the centuries which really brought her talk to life. We also saw photographs of dock workers standing in line each day in the hope of securing work. This was an immensely interesting and well delivered talk which everyone thoroughly enjoyed.

YOUR VILLAGE CHURCH OF ALL SAINTS', CRAWLEY DOWN

All Saints has Re-Opened for Private Prayer

All Saints Church is now open for private prayer **every Saturday from 10am to 12noon.**

To ensure you can visit safely, a number of changes have been made in accordance with government and Church of England guidelines.

These changes include a **revised route of access.**

Update on the Status of the Churchyard (July 2020)

Consultations and notices about our churchyard have been in place for almost two years.

The churchyard has been used for burials for the better part of 200 years and, sadly, the Parochial Church Council (PCC) (as the body responsible for it) has had to accept that the churchyard cannot decently accommodate new grave spaces. It has applied to the Ministry of Justice for a formal order discontinuing burials in new graves spaces. (Although we believe an objection has been made to that application, we are continuing to liaise with the Ministry of Justice about this).

However, when this order is made, burials will still be possible in existing family graves where they are already double or triple depth, and cremated remains can still be interred in our memorial garden. Please continue to contact the vicar and churchwardens to discuss this.

Our churchyard will still be available for our community, and we welcome all to visit it as usual. It will continue to be a place of prayer, reflection and peace as it has been for the generations before us.

If you wish to join the Churchyard Maintenance Team, help out occasionally at one of our workday parties, or contribute financially to its upkeep, please see the article on Page 10.

NEWSLETTER - SUMMER 2020

Chairman's Report

I last wrote to you all via this newsletter in May – who would have known then that our lives would still be restricted by this dreadful virus in July.

However, I remain heartened by the way that the community has come together to help each other; that strength of community spirit has not lessened, despite many weeks having passed.

We Councillors have had to learn new skills, and are now experts in virtual meeting technology. See details of our meetings below. We expect to be meeting in this way for some months to come.

One issue that we are struggling with however, is the amount of litter being generated. Both our own and Mid Sussex District Council staff have found it very difficult to keep on top of emptying bins. And a lot of time is spent picking up the litter which does not make it to a bin.

So may I request that whilst you enjoy being out and about, please can you take your litter home with you and put it in your own bin. Thank you!

In the meantime, stay healthy and safe.

The "Snake on the Green"

We know that many of the village children have enjoyed putting out their decorated rocks around the village green over the summer. However, this does cause us problems when cutting the grass, as the stones can damage our equipment or get caught up and catapulted some distance, possibly causing injury

to our groundsman or to passersby. The Council has therefore decided to remove the stones at the beginning of September, when the children will hopefully be going back to school. If you have a treasured rock, please make sure you collect it before then.

Council Play Areas

Up until 4th July, all play areas were closed as per Government instruction. New guidance was issued for re-opening play areas, but these included elements with which the Council could not comply, such as moving play equipment to ensure social distancing, operating a timed booking system for access and regular sanitization of all surfaces. This led to concerns over

validity of insurance.

It is hoped that by the time this newsletter is distributed, common sense will have prevailed and that the Council feels able to safely re-open its play areas to the public whilst still acting in accordance with Government advice.

Crawley Down Support Network (CDSN)

Since the lockdown began on 23rd March 2020 the volunteers of the Crawley Down Support Network have completed over 400 tasks for those in need within our community. These tasks have amounted to some £2,300 of essential supplies being delivered to those in isolation or shielding. Whilst the cost of these supplies was paid for by the recipient, the Crawley Down Residents Association (supported by a grant from the Parish Council) have covered all administrative and transaction costs.

Now lockdown is easing, our wonderful team of volunteers are returning to work. Alongside this, demand for support has been significantly reduced as people are able to leave their homes again. As a result, the Crawley Down Support Network will cease to operate on 1st August 2020.

From 1st August, support within Crawley Down can be accessed in the following ways.

Medication

The village pharmacy can deliver medication to those unable to collect or have someone collect for them. Please arrange this directly by calling 01342 716970.

Groceries

The Co-op have set up a community shopping scheme. You can call them on 0800 029 4592 and be matched with a volunteer who will be able to assist with essential shopping needs.

Worth Parish Council

At the beginning of lock down, the Parish Council decided to suspend all Council meetings until further notice.

The Government wrote new legislation to allow Councils to meet virtually. Worth Parish Council took advantage of this and have been holding meetings via Zoom. Please see the Council's website for details of future meeting dates; members of the public are still welcome to attend- contact the Clerk for details of how to do so.

The Annual Council Meeting scheduled for 4th May was cancelled. This may be held later in the year; in the meantime the current Chairmen/Vice Chairmen of Council and Committees remain in post.

Office staff are mainly back in the office at the Parish Hub in Copthorne, but have a staggered working pattern to minimize contact. Both the groundsmen have continued to work through the lock down period, trying to keep both our villages neat and tidy.

The Parish Council Office itself remains closed to the public for the foreseeable future – please contact the Clerk should you have to meet in person with a member of staff.

Completion of Annual Accounts 2019/2020

The Annual Governance & Accountability Return for 2019/2020 has been submitted to the external auditors. Residents are entitled to inspect the Council's accounts from 29th June to 7th August inclusive; please contact the Clerk should you wish to do so.

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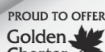
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
