HOPE IN TIME

"You made us for yourself, and our hearts are restless until they find their rest in you". St Augustine

September is usually the time when we get back to our normal routines after the summer break. With the current coronavirus pandemic, it is very different this year. However, it is possibly still a good time to consider how God calls us to make a difference in offering hope and peace to others at this challenging time. When God gave Moses the job of bringing the Israelites out of Egypt, He asked the question, "What is in your hand?" (Exodus 4:2). Moses was holding his staff, which represented his livelihood, talents, and strengths.

The 60s hit "Turn! Turn! Turn!" by the Byrds is based on verses in Ecclesiastes 3: "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens." The different seasons of life are not random, for God is in control and His timing is perfect: "He has made everything beautiful in its time." The verse goes on to say that God "has also set eternity in the human heart." This means that we all have an in-built sense that there is more to life than what we can see. We can search for meaning in life through outward and material things and while it is good to enjoy good things given to us, they can never provide ultimate fulfilment. It is only a relationship with God that fulfils us. And as we follow Christ, we are called to use our talents, temperament, experience, relationships, mind and education in the work of hope that God has given us to do each day.

There is also a mystery to Christian pilgrimage, where we have to grapple with the reality that even as we seek God, there is much in the current "season" where it's difficult to know or understand what God is doing: "no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end".

Yet even as we sometimes struggle to understand his will, and even as we face struggles and challenges each and every day we can know, in Christ, that everything has meaning and hope

The church continues to offer time for private prayer on Wednesdays and Fridays from 2pm till 4pm.

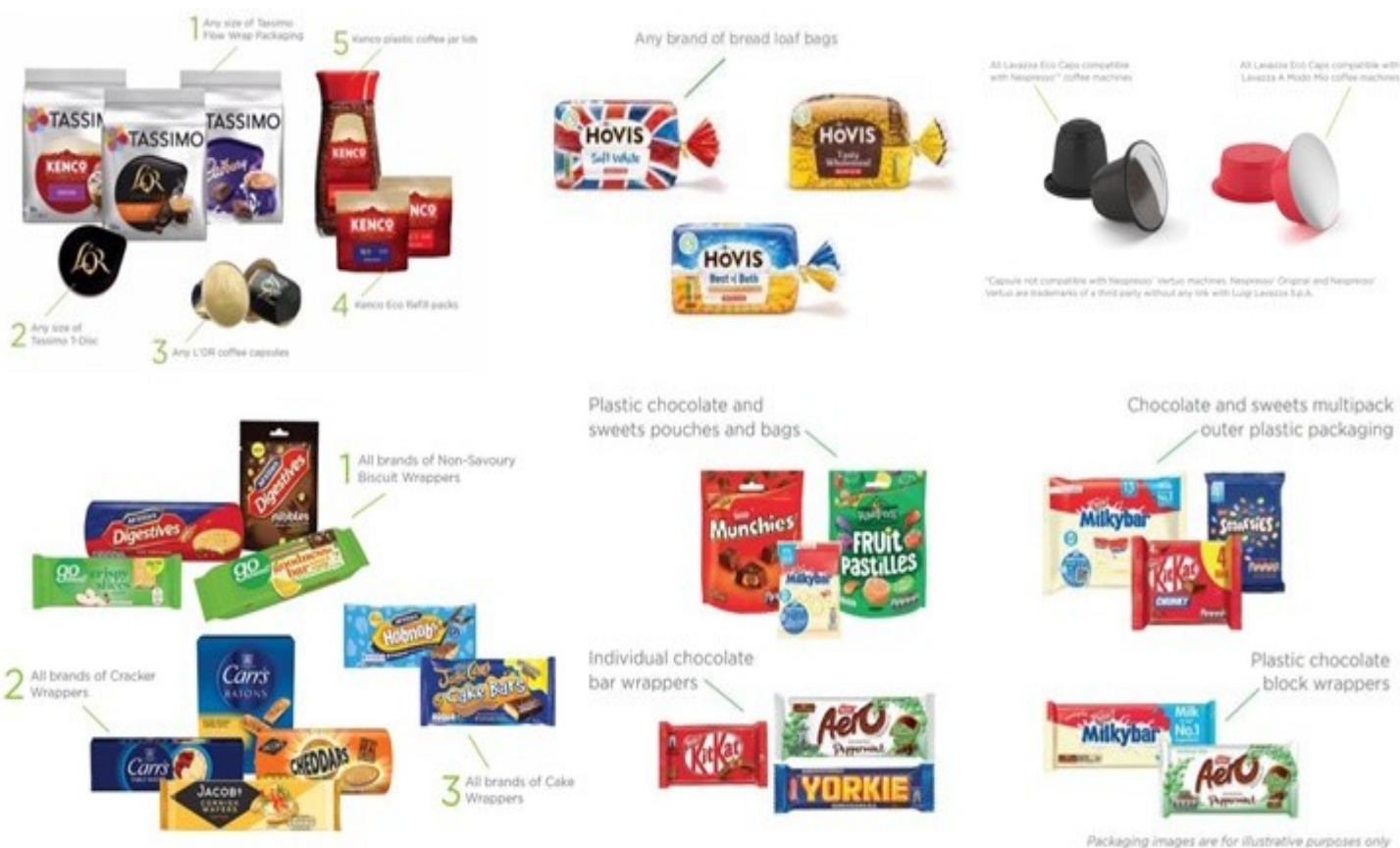
Do please remember the Quiet Garden here at Worth, which is also a lovely spot for prayer. (Follow the signs from the main car park.)

CRAWLEY DOWN RECYCLES WITH TERRACYCLE !

This is a guide to just a short list of some of the items currently accepted in the Terracycle recycling scheme that is run in Crawley Down by Hayley Wiggins. Space here does not allow for larger images so if you have any questions please email hayleywiggins@aol.com. The blue waste bin is kept permanently outside her home at 3 Kiln Road. Hayley also runs a dedicated Facebook page "Crawley Down Recycling - Terracycle" where you can find images of all the recycling schemes.



MILK BOTTLE TOPS are recycled and funds raised from their sale go directly to Great Ormond Street Children's Hospital.

ONLY MILK BOTTLE TOPS should be rinsed & bagged, and left at any of the following when they are open:

- The Pantry (delicatessen in the village)
- Crawley Down School (leave them by the office hatch during term time)

PLEASE NOTE : Bags containing miscellaneous bottle tops cannot be accepted by the recycling companies as they are a different plastic and are unfortunately thrown in landfill.

CRAWLEY DOWN VILLAGE WEBSITE GRANTS 2020

At the end of 2020, the Crawley Down website - www.crawleydownvillage.co.uk - will have been in existence for 15 years.

Readers of Crawley Down Village Magazine (formerly "Church & Village") will remember that when the website was first planned we pledged that we would use monies received from sponsors to donate to "worthy causes" in Crawley Down. True to our word, to date the Website Association has made grants totalling £22,205.

We now invite local organisations and groups to apply for a grant at the end of 2020. The eligibility criteria are simple - your group must be located in Crawley Down and must be specifically setup for the benefit of some or all of Crawley Down. Your organisation must be run on charitable lines and predominately by volunteers. Previous applicants, whether successful or not, may apply again this year.

As in previous years, a meeting will be held in early December to review the applications and decide on the recipients and the amounts to be awarded.

In previous years we have held a social evening at the Haven Centre where the names of the recipients were revealed. However, thanks to COVID-19 at this time we do not know the format - it could simply be phone calls to them, maybe a ZOOM meeting or, hopefully, back in the

Oak Room at the Haven Centre.

We will again be making payments by bank transfer and this will mean that your group, if successful, will have the grant in the bank the day following the presentation evening.

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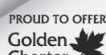
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
